Program Learning Objectives

The William Light Institute Wound Management Resource Program aims to facilitate student knowledge in holistic assessment and management of patients with or at risk of wounding.

Students will develop skills to perform the role of clinician, advisor and educator in the workplace on wound management related patient care issues.

Upon successful completion of the program the student will be able to:

- Apply knowledge of normal and altered wound healing processes to holistic patient assessment and care planning.
- Critically evaluate wound care management plans in local wound care environments.
- Demonstrate awareness of criteria for referral of wounds to relevant specialists
- Apply evidence based principles and recognised wound care standards to professional wound management practice.

Program Assessment

Individual topic assessment: including online quizzes and clinical case review learning activities.

Program Assessment: including

- Online examination of content from all topics and knowledge applied to clinical cases.
- Student presentation and evaluation of clinical case study.

Program Certification

Modular certification: Available on successful completion of each module including relevant topics.
